A meeting was held by the Board of Election Supervisors at the office at 103 So. Potomac St., Hagerstown, Md. on April 23, at 10:30 A.M.

The following Members of the Board were present:

Woodrow Rippeon was sworn in as a Member of the Board of Election Supervisors to fill the unexpired term of Brewer L. Stouffer.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and correction to same was made, Mr. McCauley, Chairman stated he had received a letter dated April 13, from Mr. Delphy, Chairman of Democrat State Committee requesting appointment of William Dorsey, as Machine Custodian. Mr. McCauley, Chairman, asked for new Motion regarding Custodian. Mr. Rippeon, made motion to withdraw Mr. Pryor's name and substitute name of William Dorsey to fill position of Machine Custodian, Motion was seconded by J. G. Hellane, and motion was unanimously passed.

Board requested I notify Board of County Commissioners of Mr. Dorsey's Appointment after we have had a letter of acceptance from Mr. Dorsey.

Machine Custodians will meet with Board later to discuss, type of work to be done on the Machines and salary.

Board agreed with the advice of their lawyer to let The Potomac Edison Co., copy list of Registered Voters within the Corporate Limits of Hagerstown, at  $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per name, and The Board of Election Supervisors would therefore re-imburse the Potomac Edison Co., with the same amount for labor for typing List. Motion was made by Mr. McCauley, Chairman and was seconded by Mr. Hellane.
