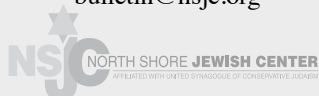

*Shabbat Shuvah refers to the Shabbat that falls during the Ten Days of Repentance between Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur. This Shabbat is named after the first word of the haftarah Hosea 14:2-10. It is perhaps a play on, but it is not to be confused with, the word "teshuvah," meaning repentance.*

## Rabbi's Desk

Rabbi Aaron Benson

*"To gain control of the world of space is certainly one of our tasks. The danger begins when in gaining power in the realm of space we forfeit all aspirations in the realm of time. There is a realm of time where the goal is not to have but to be, not to own but to give, not to control but to share, not to subdue but to be in accord. Life goes wrong when the control of space, the acquisition of things of space, becomes our sole concern."*

Abraham Joshua Heschel, *The Sabbath*



Published in 1951, Heschel's book has been a classic since it first came out. Rabbi Lawrence Kushner, himself a well-regarded scholar said about it, "Heschel's *The Sabbath* is easily the primary text for all subsequent American Jewish Spirituality."

The book is 101 pages long and Heschel's writing is poetic and gripping. Yet it's not a book to speed through and that is why I'm inviting all our congregation to spend the year reading it together with me.

Every *Shabbat* at our *mincha* study (following *kiddush* during the winter and an hour before *Havdalah* in the summer) we'll spend time reading through a few pages and discussing them. I encourage you to join us then.

In addition, throughout the year I will provide other opportunities to learn from this classic.

Karen Or Kadosh, an Israeli *Shinshinit*, is working with all the students in our Jewish Learning Center to foster their connection to and love for Israel! This is the second year that our JLC has earned a grant to sponsor a Shin-Shin's involvement in our school. This program comes to us through the Jewish Agency, the Sid Jacobson JCC, Masorti (Israeli Conservative Judaism) and the UJA.

ש"ש or שנת שירות, *Shin-Shin*, is a one-year voluntary service program for Israeli high school graduates prior to their service in the Israel Defense Forces (IDF).

Contrary to the gap year offered in other countries, the Service Year is entirely devoted to volunteer work and offers no material reward. Service Year participants work full-time in a variety of fields. In order to participate, prospective volunteers defer their compulsory military service. The number of deferments allowed by the IDF is limited however, making acceptance into the Service Year program selective and competitive. Conscription rates among Service Year graduates are nearly 100%, and many of the volunteers are accepted into the most elite units of the IDF.
