

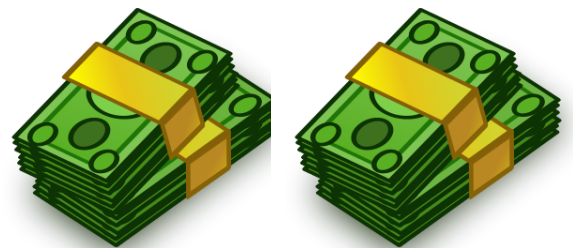
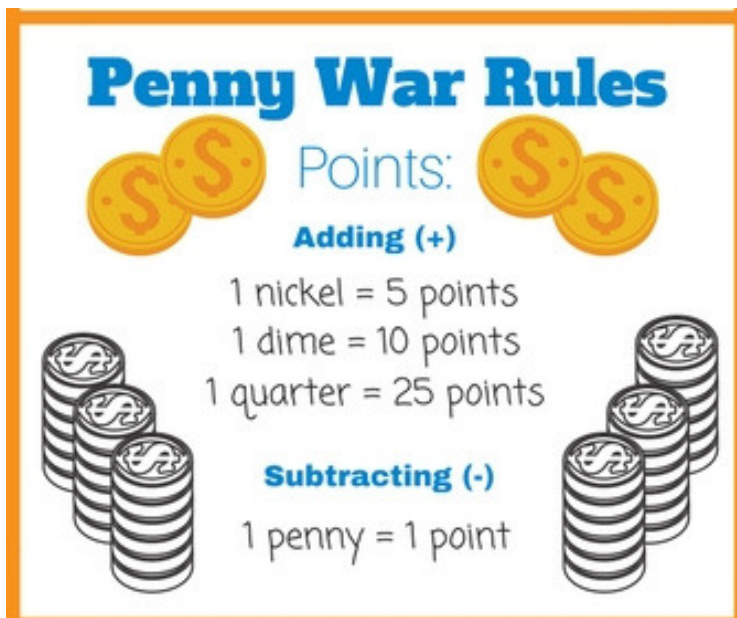
1-2-3-4 We Declare a Penny War!

Put your spare change toward a great cause. All proceeds from our penny war fundraiser will go to support bringing in more assemblies to our school!

Pennies are “negative.” Here’s how it works:

- Containers are located in the cafeteria during lunch
- Each silver coin is worth the point total of that coin—for example quarter is 25 points
- Pennies count as negative points for OTHER grades. In other words, dropping 40 pennies into another grade level’s container takes 40 points from their total—so save up those pennies!
- At the end of the day on September 20th, all change/points will be tallied and the grade level with the most points will win a popsicle party!
