Re: Possible Document Tampering by Harris County District clerk with screenshots

Dear Mr. Daniels,

I am writing to you about a great concern of mine that I am not sure how to handle in regards to my paperwork being uploaded out of order and made to not be viewable. I also noticed that the person handling the documents in question is also involved with my case as a clerk to the Judge in the 133rd. I'm concerned that this could be document tampering and involves several files within the document. Could you please confirm the laws regarding this particular situation and document tampering?

In order to help you analyze the situation, I included some information.

- 1. On May 31st, 2018, I uploaded "Plaintiff's Objection to Mediation and ADR" for cause number 2017-73029 of Court 133rd in the same manner and format that I have done previously in loading files. Each time my files online appeared uploaded in the same manner and format including the numbering of the exhibits as I had loaded them. Upon viewing the above documents one week later, I noticed that my files were loaded haphazardly, not labeled as I uploaded them, and appeared manipulated to make the files not readable. The response on the site upon attempting to open the file was that it was loaded in a unreadable format and could not open. This seems very odd as I loaded them as I always did.
- 2. At the bottom of this page, Picture 1, is a screenshot on the Harris County website of the original upload of "Plaintiff's Objection to mediation and ADR" with upload dated 5.31.2018. This screenshot was taken on 6.6.2018.
- a. Notice was made that neither the document or exhibits were viewable on 6.6.2018 upon clicking on the image. Each read "This PDF document might not be displayed correctly" and all appeared blank like the screenshot below. And the reasoning stated indicated that the document was not loaded in the appropriate format. I was very confused to this as each document and exhibit were loaded the same way as previous documents in the same pdf format as before and they loaded wonderfully. All prior uploadings appeared on the Harris County site

in the manner and order that I loaded them with no apparent discrepancy. The clerks have always been very helpful and extraordinarily patient.

- 3. I hope that I am wrong but I can only think of two scenarios to alter viewing of these documents after I loaded them; although more may be available:
- a. Since I loaded the documents correctly as seen in the screenshot, either the documents I loaded were somehow manipulated to not be viewable when reviewed or
- b. Someone gained access to the loading of the files and entered the system and changed the files after they were initially loaded to ensure that the files were not visible. I know that you can access this as I have read of clerks in California changing files for a fee to eliminate speeding tickets, altering documents for their benefit, and all and were caught by sign-on review.
- c. Even if the above are true, the haphazard loading almost appears intentional. Instead of loading as uploaded, the placement of the files/exhibits look haphazard as seen in the lack of order of exhibits, the misnumbering of exhibits, and exhibits 50, 60, and 70 did not fall under the document "Plaintiff's Objection to mediation and ADR". Instead those documents were just filed arbitrarily into the case. See picture 5.
- 4. My only conclusion falls under an intentional act which I hope is not true, but that I request for you to research this situation, knowing the issues that I am fighting in this court, the power of those whom I am fighting in this court and in another court later in the year with the mediator, Edward Trey Bergman, with whom all of my complaints revolve similar issues and the same incident. I believe these people to be powerful and influential in this industry, confirmed by many as such, and may have influenced this clerk either voluntarily or not. I am afraid of what could happen to other documents and my request for recordings of hearings and all in the courtroom itself. I need your help as to what I should do to ensure that my filings are handled carefully by this clerk, what potential issues may arise, and what you can do to help me with this clerk or how to not use this clerk. I sincerely want to know if this clerk was influenced and by whom so as to tamper with my documents and what you are doing to investigate this issue and how you can protect me, my files and future filings.
- 5. Due to this lack of viewable files and exhibits not due to my actions, I reloaded the files and exhibits and noted on the second upload that the documents were the second upload for the reason seen below and were uploaded a second time in the same manner and form as the first upload (picture 4).

- 6. After the upload of the second set of the same document and exhibits for "Plaintiff's Objection to mediation and ADR" on 6.7.2018, the documents and exhibits said to be in the wrong format from the first load suddenly became visible. Of greatest interest is the original document that read to not be readable leading to a second upload, suddenly appeared readable after the second upload. This is of greatest interest as the second upload stated on the first page of the document "Plaintiff's Objection to mediation and ADR" that it was the second upload to distinguish from the first upload. Hence, the first upload was always capable of being viewable, but for some strange and unknown reason, the initial loading of the original document and exhibits were somehow altered to be unable to be read until I loaded the documents a second time. I find this most interesting and wonder why such care was not taken with the first document upload and why such was done so poorly as to not be viewable or if such were possibly manipulated intently as in document tampering for the benefit of someone or to make a statement for some reason. I then noticed that the clerk, Evelyn Palmer, stamped the original documents that failed to be loaded accurately.
- 7. According to the County Clerk in the press release dated February 26, 2010, "The people entrust the County Clerk with records which are dear to them... and other important documents." The haphazard manner in which the first upload occurred and most importantly the fact that neither the document, exhibits or any of that upload was visible until the second upload seems to distract from this entrustment. The total number of documents loaded wrong are six and the total manipulated to not be viewable is nine. I believe that those entrusted with loading such important documents seem to have been very knowledgable in the past and wonder why at this time with these documents that are very revealing would not be treated with just as much care.

Reason for Request and Great Concern over the Immediate Investigation of this Incident

8. I suppose my greatest concern as to why the clerk manipulated my files, if such happened, lies in the prior issues that I have experienced since filing this case. Since my original filing in October 2017, I experienced events that I have never experienced including received malware from the lawyers one month after filing against them that can completely wipe a computer; a break-in of the pharmacy where I work without drug loss but trashing of the area; one week later a bullet through office window next door to the pharmacy; my home windows unlocked but alarm set without my knowledge; intimidation from a driver who followed and tailed me on hwy 59 at 10:30p from 80mph to 51mph for 8 miles until I finally pulled behind and

prevented him siding me until I was able to lose them with passing of cars and exit, and so on.

And now I have what appears to be document tampering of a very upfront and truthful file in

regards to why I do not want to go to mediation/ADR and still await the Judge's decision. As

such, I would like to know why this occurred and whether this clerk may have felt

intimidated to load or alter these files in any way for any person or group of persons.

9. Please accept my sincere apologies if I am out of line here with my grave concerns for

my case. I am working very hard to keep up in an environment completely alien to me in an

effort to fight against what I feel is negligence, manipulation, conspiracy, Fraud on the Court,

forgery and more in my lawsuit with documents that I feel support those claims. And although I

would like to have a lawyer, lawyer#12 told me that no one will represent me as that would be

"legal suicide" as everyone is afraid of Bergman and what he can do to those in this industry.

Her words prove amazingly truthful. The appearance and viewability of my documents are

important to me as I progress in this fight. When exhibits are not loaded in the format to support

the document, the meaning and objectives could be lost as well as the case.

10. Thank you for your attention to this matter. I hope that you are able to clarify the

situation and address to me why this clerk felt the need to not apply the same deligence as the

other clerks in handling my documents. And I look forward to your suggestions and actions, and

opinions on how I can successfully deal with my documents and all whilst this clerk is the clerk

of the court where my case is active.








Picture 3: This shows the Second pdf upload that triggered the original upload to become visible without any change in the upload format of the original.



Picture 4 shows the exact same upload format for the updated as the original except the second upload proved to somehow allow the first upload to be visible. Both uploads are identical in form but both uploads did not produce the same results. The first upload was haphazard, radical in placement, and lacking coherency whilst the second one not so. Both uploads should have produced the same results. Had I not noticed the discrepancy and filed the second upload, I feel that the original filings would have remained hidden and am unsure of the consequences to such.



Picture 5 screenshot of all filings shows the discombobulated format of the original objection to ADR versus the filings of others. This disorder is no fault of mine as I did both identically. Could such a displacement and lack of view-ability for the original objection upload have been intentional since the subject matter could be viewed as an intention for the Defendants to conspire in addition to negligence, Fraud on the Court, and assault? Was the clerk influenced to do this and by whom?
