
Set Trap Diagram

West Coast Mole


For deeper burrowing West Coast Moles, use a trowel to dig closer to the tunnel. Set the trap lower than the grade.

Trapping Moles


Test active mole runs 24 hrs before setting traps. Step down once on several different runs. Active runs will show signs of repair within 24 hours.




Use a slender stick to measure down through the run to the bottom of the tunnel. Make sure that the **Loops** of the Mega-Grip® will reach the floor of the tunnel.



Set the trap by compressing the **Spring** with both hands.



Hold the **Spring** against the **Base** with one hand. Move the **Trigger** over the **Spring** with the other hand.



Hold the **Trigger** down with your thumb and place the end of the trigger into the **Trip Pan Slot**. The trap is now set.



Mark the top of the run with the **Loops** of the trap.



Use a flat spade to make two slots across the run. The slots must be slightly deeper than the floor of the tunnel.



Place the set trap in the spade slots and push down with your foot. Make sure the **Trigger** is still engaged with the **Trip Pan Slot** before removing foot.



Hold the **Trigger** in the **Trip Pan Slot** and with the other hand, collapse a small area of the tunnel directly under the **Trip Pan**.
