High school students in the HOV Teen Volunteer Program visit patients for two hours each week and brighten their days with conversation, reading, playing games, and listening to music. Participants must make a 12-month commitment to volunteering two hours per week (weekdays after school or weekends) and must complete 18 hours of orientation.
