We are returning, unfiled, the proposed Restated Articles of Incorporation for the subject corporation.

The corporate powers, rights and privileges were suspended by the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) on 12/02/2013. Questions concerning the reason for the suspension or the requirements for reinstatement must be directed to FTB at 1-800-852-5711. Except for the purposes of filing an application for exempt status (with FTB) or amending the articles of incorporation as necessary either to perfect that application or to set forth a new corporate name, an amendment to the articles of incorporation may not be filed while the corporation is suspended. (Revenue & Taxation Code § 23301.)

Please note: If the proposed amendment is being filed at the request of the Franchise Tax Board (FTB), return the amendment with a copy of FTB's letter requesting the changes.

Article II does not contain the statement required by California Corporations Code section 5130(b), which should be contained in the Articles of Incorporation exactly as it is provided in the code section. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for "charitable" purposes.*"

The California Corporations Code prohibits any amendment of the Articles of Incorporation to add or alter the statement of the initial street address and initial mailing address of the corporation, the names and addresses of the first directors, or the name and address of the agent for service of process. Please delete Article III. See California Corporations Code section 9620.

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned certify that:

- 1) They are the president and the secretary, respectively, of The American Youth Leadership Commission Inc., a California corporation.
- 2) The Articles of Incorporation of this corporation are amended and restated to read as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be The American Youth Leadership Commission Inc.

ARTICLE II

A. The Corporation is a nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation organized exclusively for charitable purposes and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

B. The purpose of this corporation is to provide leadership, opportunity, and services to underserved and disadvantaged young people, including refugees and immigrants, in order to facilitate their growth and development as happy, healthy, productive individuals in support of vibrant, sustainable communities. The corporation may utilize the arts, entertainment, and education as catalysts to promote creativity, economic vitality, business and job creation, financial literacy, resiliency, and wellness to provide a foundation and compass for children and youth. This corporation may engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law.

ARTICLE IV

A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from

ARTICLE IV

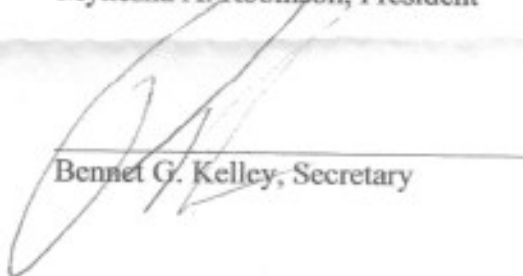

- 3) The foregoing amendment and restatement of Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the board of directors.
- 4) The corporation has no members.
