Blueprint Workplace Success Program and Life Skills Programs are to be facilitated in partnership with the USC Cecil Murray Center for Community Engagement. Youth Workshops should be scheduled daily with rotating Trained Millennial Instructors during the hours of 1-4:00 pm and 5-8:00 pm daily Monday thru Friday. The Accelerated Youth Leadership Program will consist of a selection of 30 Students through a competitive process. The learning curriculum will include the Blueprint for Workplace Success and Life Skills Curriculum while engaging in an active learning style like USC "Passing the Mantle" model which aims to teach public policy and community engagement to youth while enhancing their capacity to engage in meaningful employment and career paths in public service.
