

During the previous month The Kentucky/Indiana Ambassadors have continued in sharing NSDOAF with others during genealogical meetings and daily life. I have researched which colleges have an agriculture program in Kentucky and Indiana and prepared an information packet regarding our scholarship program and membership in NSDOAF and sent to each bursar or financial aid officer with those colleges.
