

MEN'S SECTION COMMITTEE MEETING

7th June 2019

1. JD requested an extension of time (1 week) to allow him to complete his internal competitions fixtures. Ill health has prevented him from taking part in some games but he is now able to fulfil his commitments. An extension was granted on the understanding that his opponents were agreeable.
2. JD brought to the attention of the meeting that some members were not paying the required amount for refreshments, with some also taking excessive numbers of biscuits. He suggested that the price of tea/coffee should be increased.
Members are advised that when providing refreshments to visiting teams it is the responsibility of each Skip to ensure that payment for his/her rink is made. Visiting teams are not expected to pay for refreshments. The price of tea/coffee will remain unchanged for the present time.
3. RM advised that he and LW had met with Benny Watts of N.East Procore Services, and with the agreement of the management committee had arranged to have the green aerated at a cost of £100. Further possible work to be undertaken by NEPS will be discussed at a later date. It is hoped to research grant provision to allow further green maintenance.
4. LW reported that he had sent an e-mail to Property Services requesting an update on our request for renovation work to be carried out on the pavilion and the boards surrounding the green. A reply is awaited.
5. DR reminded the meeting that the Club 4's competition was scheduled to take place on Sunday 9th June, but would only take place if a minimum of 16 members registered to play on the day. LW advised that the prize money for the competition amounted to £60 and that if only 16 members took part there would be a £52 cost to the club. The matter will be considered by the management committee.
