

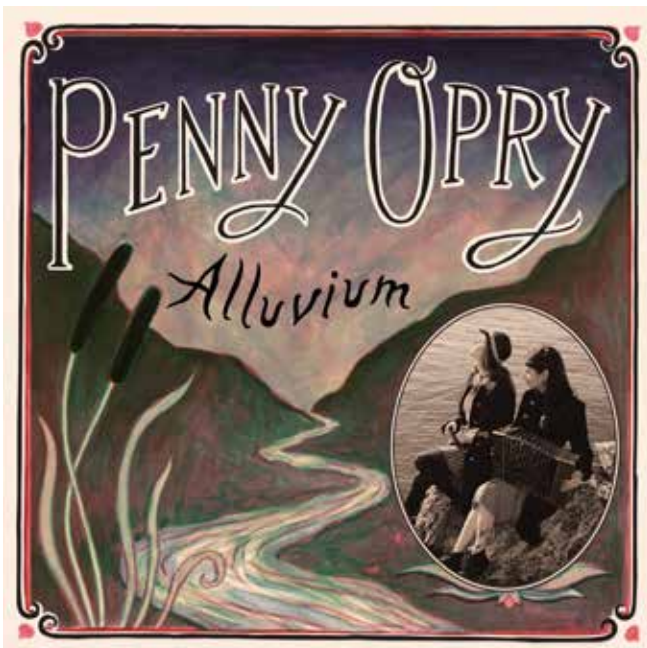
Penny Opry Announces a New Maritime-Inspired Folk Album **Alluvium**

Penny Opry is pleased to announce the release of their debut album **Alluvium**, a musical journey back in time, inspired by riverboats, tin-pan alley, and sea chanties, fueled by whiskey and unrefined charm.

Based in the San Francisco Bay Area, Joan Wilson Rueter and Rosie Steffy have spent the better part of the past eight years traveling together and honing their skills, performing everywhere from taverns and coffee shops to international folk music festivals in France, Sweden, Germany, The Netherlands, and The United States. The duo's latest incarnation, Penny Opry, delves far into folk music of the past, drawing inspiration from Tin Pan Alley, old-time Americana, and maritime folk music.

Alluvium features songs about rivers, canals, weather, the Great Lakes, and the sea. The album showcases the duo's sister-style harmonies and multi-instrumentalism, featuring an antique button accordion, a suitcase drum kit, soprano and baritone ukuleles, fiddle, guitar, mandolin, and piano. Eight of the album's tracks were sourced from folk tradition or early sound recordings and sheet music from the Library of Congress; the remaining three songs are Penny Opry originals.
