Instructional

- Provide high quality teaching in the technical, physiological, and mental aspects of athletic performance in the sport of rowing.
- Provide constructive feedback to rowers during practice.
- Motivate rowers in a positive environment.
- Maintain discipline with regard to RRC policies as well as team-centric standards.

Environmental

- Create a positive learning experience and environment for rowers and coxswains.

Head Coaching Responsibilities

- Maintain and run an organized, technically structured, and physiologically sound training program for assigned team and crews.
- Develop and lead a positive team culture based on the values of the GPRF.
- Lead administrative tasks, such as roster management, waiver compliance and attendance tracking.
- Lead the scheduling of resources, including coaching, for effective practice and competition for the specified program.
- Deploy assistant coaches, interns and outside experts in order to maximize athlete development.
- Collaborate with the Director of Rowing Operations to ensure pathways of participation and development for athletes are effective.
- Leads program staff in recruiting and retaining participants to achieve GPRF participation goals.
- Develop, lead and evaluate the team's pursuit of appropriate competitive goals.
- Set competition schedule in alignment with team goals.
- Collaborate with Regatta Coordinator to schedule logistics for competition.
- Build effective structures of athlete leadership to aid communication pathways between the coach and the athletes.
