NOT EQUAL GIFTS. BUT EQUAL SACRIFICE.

Stewardship Sunday, November 17

Dear Members and Friends of Pierce Chapel:

This coming Sunday is a special day in the life of our church as we will be celebrating our annual STEWARDSHIP SUNDAY. You will be given opportunity in each service to consecrate your giving to the ministries of Pierce Chapel and to Building By Faith (debt elimination) for 2020. This is a faithful thing to do, and helps immensely in our ministry planning and debt elimination for the coming year.

Once again our theme is GROWING IN FAITH TOGETHER. Our goal is 100% participation - but not with equal gifts. The challenge is equal sacrifice from the entire church family—members and regular attendees. Obviously, we can't all give the same amount, but we can all make the same sacrifice by giving the same percentage. This is the wisdom of the Biblical tithe (10% of income) that scripture teaches belongs to God.

I trust that you received a letter from me last week that included an Estimate of Giving Card for 2020. Please bring this with you Sunday, but we will have more available if needed. There will also be available a STEP UP TO TITHING guide and a brochure outlining our 2020 preliminary budget.

All we have comes from God and belongs to God. What God requires is that we return the tithe for Kingdom support and use the rest to support faithful living. We know that most people are not tithers, but please struggle prayerfully with this. Use the STEP UP TO TITHING guide to help you set up a plan that will get you to the level of tither over a period of time.

Remember, the goal is equal sacrifice, not equal amounts. This is not only fair but faithful. And know that your contributions will directly and positively impact the success and effectiveness of our ministries together. I encourage you to make every effort to be present this Sunday, November 17, so you can return an estimate of your giving and make known your participation as a faithful financial steward of Pierce Chapel.



Pies for Our PIE



Remember those who are hungry this Thanksgiving. On November 23, we will observe a day of fasting that we call "Fasturday" to help raise awareness of the problem of hunger in our community. We invite you to do three things:



- 1. **Bring** canned goods and non-perishable food items to Pierce Chapel between Sunday, November 10, and Sunday, November 24, to help Wynnton Neighborhood Network for the holiday season.
- 2. <u>Fast</u> (if your health allows) on Saturday, November 23, to become familiar with the feelings of hunger that some people in our community experience every day.
- 3. <u>Pray</u> for the poor and those in our community who suffer from hunger and "food insecurity."

As you are filling your bags, you may want to include some of the following items:
