

Free time each day includes the beach, pool and organized rec tournaments like strong man/woman, volleyball, basketball and Ultimate Frisbee. Souled Out is open to students finishing 6th grade through those finishing 12th grade. Cost is \$350 as of May 1/student and covers all expenses (except 2 travel meals) including transportation, t-shirt, great food, and 5 nights lodging. Scholarships are available to all students. A note from Samuel (translated):


