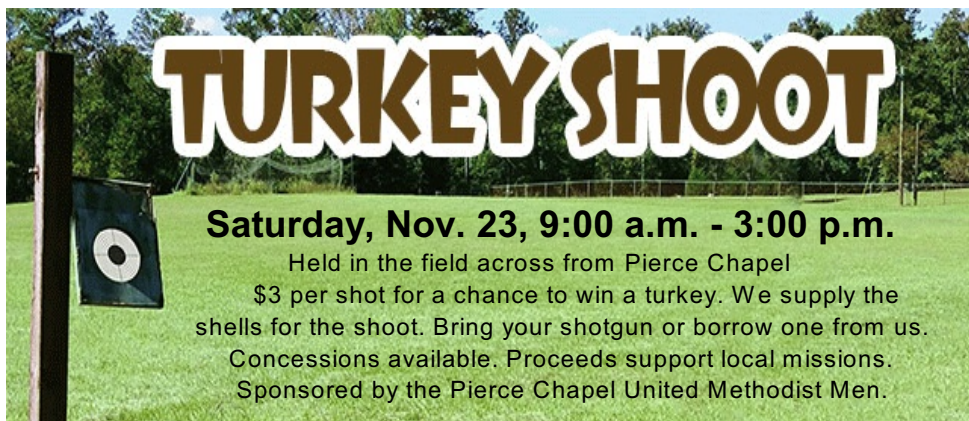

Remember those who are hungry this Thanksgiving. On November 23, we will observe a day of fasting that we call "Fasturday" to help raise awareness of the problem of hunger in our community. We invite you to do three things:



1. **Bring** canned goods and non-perishable food items to Pierce Chapel between Sunday, November 10, and Sunday, November 24, to help Wynnton Neighborhood Network for the holiday season.
2. **Fast** (if your health allows) on Saturday, November 23, to become familiar with the feelings of hunger that some people in our community experience every day.
3. **Pray** for the poor and those in our community who suffer from hunger and "food insecurity."

As you are filling your bags, you may want to include some of the following items:

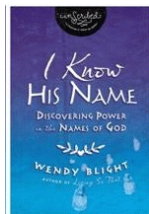

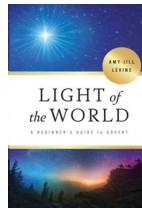
New Mary/Martha Bible Study
