Watercolor basics: Controlled washes, line work, mixing colors, brush strokes, hard and soft edges, and composition. We will be working on a California Hills Painting.

The following is a suggested materials list. Many of you already have enough Items to start paintings. For those who are new:

Transparent watercolor tube paints: Suggested Colors: Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Sap Green, Lemon Yellow, Orange, Yellow Ochre, Ultramarine Blue, Black, Cobalt Violet And Windsor Red

Watercolor paper or block: Get 140 lb. Arches Rough paper (1), Size 22" X 30" and then cut the sheet into quarters or you can buy a 12" X 16" multi sheet block that has all sides secured to the edge. These blocks are great to work on.

You will need a watercolor palette, pencil, a board to work on, some pushpins, old rag and masking tape and a recepticle for holding water.

Brushes: Make sure they are watercolor brushes. Size: 3/4" flat, #3, #6, #12 Rounds (inexpensive Hake is fine) The very best brushes are Red Sables.
