The TechCred program is designed to train incumbent workers for in-demand jobs in Ohio. The goal is to build a stronger workforce in our technology-infused economy.

Financial Awards for Employers Available!

In partnership with a training provider like Clark State, employers can apply online to be **reimbursed up to \$2,000*** of training costs once the employee has successfully completed a credential. Qualified credentials must be short-term (less than one year to complete), technology focused and industry recognized.

**\$2,000 per employee, up to \$30,000 total available per funding round.*
