Open Division (Badminton Victoria Perpetual Trophy)

Second Division (Lenny Permana Perpetual Trophy)

Depending on the number of entries received, teams may play qualifier matches to determine the division the team will play the rest of its tournament matches.

Open Division is an elite competition for schools who are generally winners or runners-up in their respective school association competition, have club, state or national level player(s) in their team or are looking for a significantly higher level of competition.

Second Division is for schools wishing to experience a greater level of competition outside their respective school associations or may not have competitive badminton being played in their school association.

There are no gender divisions. Boys and girls will all compete together.

Entry Format:

Due to the demand for places in this event entries are staggered. This is the first round of entries. If there are still places available at the close of the first round of entries, a second round will be opened. If there are still places available at the end of the second round a third round will be opened. Payment will be made once all entry rounds have been completed. Names for teams and players will be required once all rounds have been completed. You will be sent an invoice and details of how to enter team and player names at the end of the entry rounds.

Withdrawals:

Teams may withdraw from the championships until 6 September 2019 by emailing events@badmintonvic.com.au. Any withdrawals after issuance of invoices will not be refunded.

Conditions of Entry

- 1. **REGULATIONS:** The tournament will be conducted initially in accordance with the BV Generic Polices, Sport Injury and Risk Management Standards as adopted by Badminton Victoria, followed by the Laws of Badminton & Player Code of Conduct as adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), except where modified by these conditions.
- 2. AUTHORITY: Badminton Victoria (BV) shall have the entire control and management of the tournament which will be in accordance with the Laws of Badminton except where modified by these conditions. BV has the right to reject or regrade entries and to issue invitations to additional teams to fill any vacancy in the draw. BV reserves the right to cancel an event if insufficient entries are received. Badminton Victoria reserves the right to change, alter or edit all facets of the tournament including but not limited to tournament structure, point scoring systems, draws and scheduling.

- 3. **MEDIA CONSENT:** Participants consent to the collection of their details and image by tournament organisers and understand that such information may be passed onto and used by Badminton Victoria Inc. Entrants and players acknowledge their right to access and correct such information.
- 4. **TEAM ENTRY:** Team Entries and payment for entry fees must be received according to the schedule above. Teams must be entered by the participating School.
- 5. **TEAM GUARDIAN:** Each team must be accompanied by a teacher, coach or parent over the age of 18 years old to act as a guardian for team members.
- 6. **PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:** All players must be current students from Prep to Year 6 of the participating school.
- 7. **PLAYER RANKING:** Players must be listed and ranked in order of merit on the entry form. Any changes to the Team Ranking List can be approved prior to the start of the event and subject to the Event Director's discretion. Team Managers/Captains/Contacts will receive a copy of the all Team Ranking Lists for their competition during the Managers Meeting. Each team is responsible for checking that team nominations in a match agree with the relevant team ranking list.
- 8. **DIVISIONS:** Badminton Victoria will provide two: Open Division and Second Division. Depending on the number of entries received, teams may play qualifier matches to determine the division the team will play the rest of its tournament matches.

Open Division is elite competition for schools who are generally a winner or runner-up on their respective school association competition, have club, state or national level player(s) in their team or are looking for a significantly higher level of competition.

Second Division is for schools wishing to experience a greater level of competition outside their respective school associations or may not have competitive badminton being played in their school association.

- 9. **MATCH COMPOSITION:** Where time will allow, each match will comprise of 6 doubles games, of any gender or age combination.
- 10. **TEAM COMPOSITION:** Teams shall consist of 4-6 players of any gender, age or ability.
- 11. **TEAM NOMINATION:** Further details will be available on the day.
- 12. **PLAYER NOMINATION:** Players may not play in more than 3 games per match. Players may not play with the same partner twice in a match. Requests for player substitutes during a match can be made to the Event Director.
- 13. **INSUFFICIENT PLAYERS:** A team with an insufficient number of players to contest all games shall nominate for and complete as many of the games as possible, with the matches of the lowest position/s or merit to be forfeited.
- 14. **COMPETITION DRAW:** Matches can only be played within the allocated session times, unless alternatively advised by the Event Director. Draws will be made available via the <u>Tournament Website</u>.

Teams will be allocated into round robin groups where they will play other teams in that round robin group. After the initial round robin stage, teams will be positioned into another round robin group or playoff match to decide winners and final placings. The number of entries will determine the final structure and is subject to change.

- 15. **ORDER OF PLAY:** Where an order of play cannot be agreed upon between opposing teams, the order of play will revert to the following: Strongest pair doubles first through to the weakest pair doubles last.
- 16. **GAME SCORING FORMAT:** Where possible, all games will be 1 game to 15 rally points (no setting). A change of ends will occur when one team reaches their 8th point.
- 17. MATCH SCORING FORMAT: 1 Game Point is awarded per game won by a team. A Game Point is not awarded for any incomplete games, but points in progress must be recorded on the scoresheet and Match form to be included in overall points. The winner of the Match is the Team with the most Game Points and is awarded 2 Match Points for the session. If Game Points are tied, a Match Draw is declared for the match and each Team receives 1 Match Point.
- 18. **ROUND ROBIN SCORING FORMAT:** Ladder positions in a round robin will be determined by the number of Match Points won (i.e. The team with the most Match Points will be positioned first on the ladder). For teams that tied on the ladder, the team with the most rally points, will be positioned higher on the ladder. If rally points are tied between teams, their position will be determined by the head-to-head result between affected teams.
- 19. **SCORE KEEPING:** Teams are responsible for umpiring matches and recording scores and players names/teams accurately in the game scoresheets and Match Forms. Game scoresheets must be submitted to the control desk immediately after completion. Match Forms must be submitted to the control desk after the completion of a match for data entry.
- 20. **FINAL PLAYOFF MATCH:** For a Final Playoff Match outside of the Round Robin format, the winner of the Match will be the team with the most Game Points at the end of the session. Should there be a tie in Game Points, the team with the most rally points in the Match will be the winner of the Match. Should there be a tie in rally points, the team with the greater points difference (for-against) overall in the competition will win the match.
- 21. **SHUTTLECOCKS:** Feathered shuttlecocks will be used.
- 22. **MEDALS:** BV will provide medallions to team players in first, second and third place for each division. All players will receive a participation certificate at the end of the competition.
