## Impact Austin Receives Outstanding Philanthropic Organization Award

Girls Giving Grants was founded to help guide and nurture the future generation of philanthropists. Each girl, in grades 8-12, contributes \$100 of her own money and members evaluate their own pool of grant applications. The g3 program is unique among collective giving organizations nationwide.

Impact Austin is volunteer-driven, with each member contributing \$1,250 annually and each member's vote counting equally in determining grant recipients. Members have an opportunity to be as involved as they like from volunteering on an assortment of standing committees, to participating on a Grant Review Committees to simply attending the Annual Meeting and casting their vote.
