My husband and I lost our first son on September 28th, 2006, shortly after birth and a year later on September 27th, 2007, we lost our second son when I was 15 weeks pregnant. September 11th brings back memories for all of us. I remember frantically calling friends

and family in Washington, DC, and New York to make sure they were safe and watching the horrible events unfold on TV. This year Central Texas has been ravaged by wildfires, and my hometown suffered a hurricane and earthquake. I have talked to Impact Austin members who have suffered losses in their family, endured surgeries, divorce and illness.

How do we make it through all of these things? For many of us it has been community, the community of friends, community of family, community of our places of worship, and community of nonprofits.

I have found a new community in Impact Austin. Women who are so dedicated to making a difference in their community truly make you want to belong. I had the opportunity to attend the Girls Giving Grants service project at People's Community Clinic, where the girls assembled 50 baby baskets for teen mothers. The girls were so excited to see their dollars at work and to learn about the Impact they were making on the community. After the event, I headed to Whole Foods to do my weekend grocery shopping. When I checked out at the register the clerk laughed and said, "Hey Liz, where have you been today with your name tag!" After sheepishly removing my name tag, I explained to her about Impact Austin and the Girls Giving Grants project, and she began to get a little teary. She said that 15 years ago she was a teen mom. Without the help of People's Community Clinic she would have not made it. She proudly said that she and her daughter were doing very well. I was so PROUD to be a part of Impact Austin and could not wait to get home and tell my family.

So this September, I plan to embrace community even more! On September 11th, I attended a baby shower for friends (and an Impact Austin member) who recently brought home their daughter through the miracle of adoption. In honor of our daughter and in memory of our children, my family will celebrate September by giving back to our community in our children's name through the necklace/support program we have started for women who lose a child during pregnancy. I will continue to work hard for Impact
