Prevent further spillage. Adsorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with Fire foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away. FIRST AID If Swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting.
