# Speaker – Joe Jungwirth, a Graduate Student whose thesis was completed on The Effect of Electromagnetic Fields produced by WiFi Routers on the Magnetite Particles of the Italian Honey Bee.

His findings: There is magnetic substance in bee abdomen (from ingesting pollen). Joe verified size of particles.

No "significant" difference found between particle size before and after exposure to WiFi router EMF. No "significant" difference found between particle abundance before and after exposure to WiFi router EMF
