Neighbor To Neighbor Fundraiser

Soup Supper Set for November 10th at St. Paul Lutheran Church

The Neighbor To Neighbor Program will host its annual fundraiser soup supper on Sunday, November 10th from 5:00 to 6:30 pm at St. Paul Lutheran Church, 2012 O Street, in Auburn.

"We will be offering chili, chicken noodle and ham and bean soups," says Neighbor To Neighbor Program Director Laura Osborne. "We will also have relishes, crackers, beverages and desserts."

Neighbor to Neighbor serves Nemaha County senior citizens who need basic assistance in order to remain living independently in their homes. The program matches senior citizen volunteers with clients to provide services such as transportation, minor home repair, basic cleaning, and more. The program utilizes grant funding and donations for its annual operations.

"Having the support of the community is increasingly important," notes Osborne. "This year, we have seen a decrease in the amount of people signing up to volunteer with our program. If anyone over age 60 is interested in becoming a volunteer, we encourage them to call 402-274-4277 to discuss it with me!"

On November 10th, everyone is encouraged to take time out to enjoy supper at the Neighbor To Neighbor fundraiser. All proceeds from the soup supper will benefit the Neighbor To Neighbor Program. 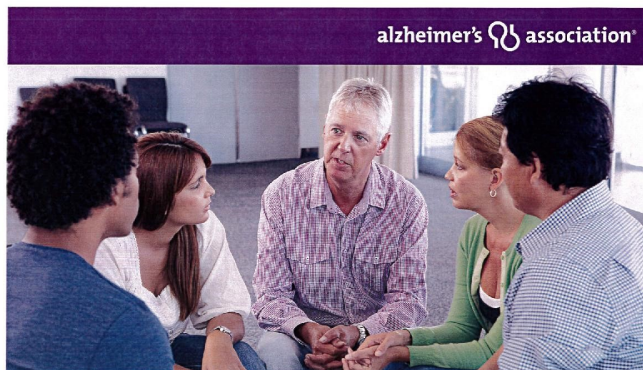

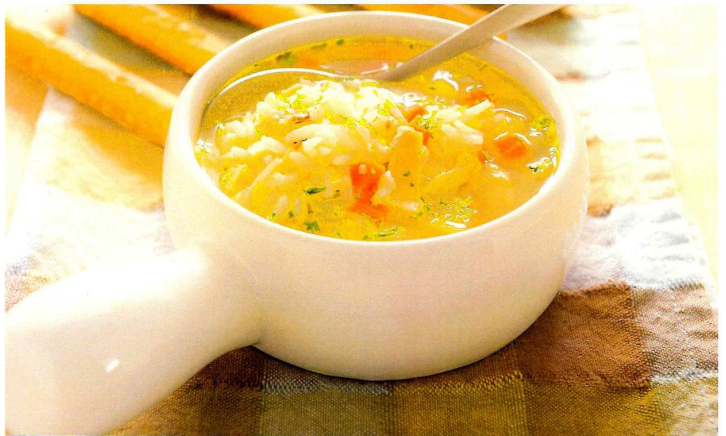

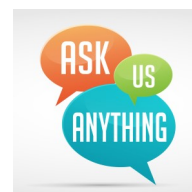
