THE SEASON OF ADVENT

This weekend we'll celebrate the first Sunday of Advent. Over the next four weeks, as we light candles that represent Hope, Peace, Joy and Love, we are preparing and reminding ourselves of the real meaning of Christmas.

As Blessed John Henry Newman reminds us in a homily for the Advent Season: "Advent is a time of waiting, it is a time of joy because the coming of Christ is not only a gift of grace and salvation but it is also a time of commitment because it motivates us to live the present as a time of responsibility and vigilance. This 'vigilance' means the necessity, the urgency of an industrious, living 'wait'. To make all this happen, then we need to wake up, as we are warned by the apostle to the Gentiles, in today's reading to the Romans: 'Besides this you know what hour it is, how it is full time now for you to wakfrom sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed" (Rm 13:11).

GARDA VETTING

Balbriggan Parish has been asked by the Archdiocese of Dublin for all Ministers of the Eucharist, Ministers of the Word, Choir members and all Church volunteers to renew their Garda Vetting to meet the new criteria that has been recently introduced.

Please be advised of an amendment to the 100 point identification check for Garda Vetting.

The Archdiocese of Dublin can no longer accept Public Service Cards as a means to validate identity. There are however a number of other identification options available to you. Essentially, the GNVB requires Relevant Organisations to verify the name, date of birth and current address of the applicant in addition to a form of photographic identity proof. This will mean at least two different forms of ID, one of which should be photographic. Garda Vetting Forms are available from the Sacristy to be returned to the Parish Office.
