GARDA VETTING

Balbriggan Parish has been asked by the Archdiocese of Dublin for all Ministers of the Eucharist, Ministers of the Word, Choir members and all Church volunteers to renew their Garda Vetting to meet the new criteria that has been recently introduced.

Please be advised of an amendment to the 100 point identification check for Garda Vetting. The Archdiocese of Dublin can no longer accept Public Service Cards as a means to validate identity. There are however a number of other identification options available to you.

Essentially, the GNVB requires Relevant Organisations to verify the name, date of birth and current address of the applicant in addition to a form of photographic identity proof. This will mean at least two different forms of ID, one of which should be photographic.
