GARDA VETTING

Balbriggan Parish has been asked by the Archdiocese of Dublin for all Ministers of the Eucharist, Ministers of the Word, Choir members to renew their Garda Vetting to meet the new criteria that has been recently introduced.

The Archdiocese of Dublin can no longer accept Public Service Cards as a means to validate identity. The GNVB requires Relevant Organisations to verify the name, date of birth and current address of the applicant in addition to a form of photographic identity proof. This will mean at least two different forms of ID, one of which should be photographic. Garda Vetting Forms are available from the Sacristy to be returned to the Parish Office.
