


Coalition-building in the next European Parliament - a challenging endeavor


- Grand-Coalition (EPP, S&D): 45% of seats;
- Super grand coalition (S&D, Renew Europe, EPP): 59% of seats;
- Super progressive coalition (GUE/NGL, 5 Star Movement, Greens/EFA, S&D, Renew Europe): 53% of seats;
- Super conservative coalition (EPP, ECR, Identity & Democracy, Brexit Party): 47% of seats;
- Centre-right coalition (Renew Europe, EPP, ECR): 47% of seats;
- Left coalition (GUE/NGL, 5 Star Movement, Greens/EFA, S&D): 39% of seats





Political spectrum in the European Parliament after the EU elections























Less restrictive measures on inclusion of asylum seekers into the labour market






Support for stricter due diligence requirements for downstream importers of conflict minerals
