A LITTLE ABOUT THE BAND:

Jazz Community is an 18-piece big band playing the music of Count Basie, Duke Ellington, Stan Kenton, Thad Jones and many more. The band was established in 1976 by its late founder and director, trumpet player and music educator, Bill May. Jazz Community played weekly at several restaurants and supper clubs, as well as many outdoor festivals and street fairs, private events and weddings, throughout the Chicagoland area for over 12 years. With the untimely passing of founder and director Bill May, in the fall of 1991, Jazz Community disbanded.

In the fall of 2011, under the leadership of Bill's sister, Marianne May, and with several charter members in tow, *Jazz Community* reunited for a one-time event to honor Bill on the twentieth anniversary of his passing and to celebrate the musical contributions he made to the many lives he touched. With that successful reunion under its belt, the band decided it was time to get back on the jazz scene. With Marianne as the band's leader, and co-music director Leo Kawczinski, *Jazz Community* is now back on track, swinging hard and delighting Chicagoland big band fans once again with regular monthly performances in Elmhurst, several appearances each year at FitzGerald's in Berwyn, the Jazz Showcase in Chicago, and other venues throughout the city and suburbs.
