Educational resources are provided to help patients effectively advocate for themselves and navigate the complexities of the healthcare.

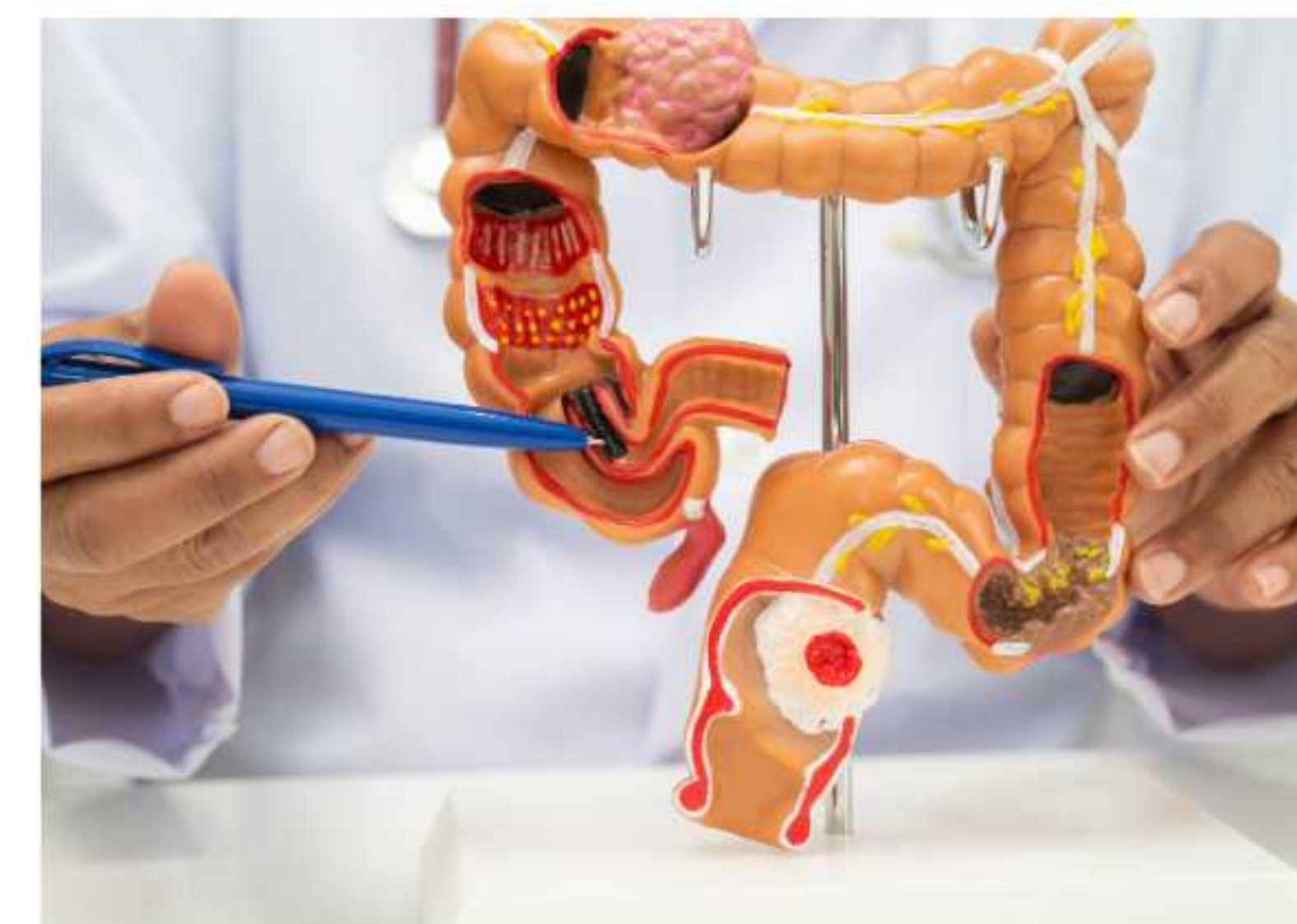
PATIENT RIGHTS & LEGAL ASSISTANCE
