# OVERVIEW

Accessing support services is essential for Colorectal Cancer patients to navigate the emotional, physical, and financial challenges of their diagnosis.

## AVENUES FOR SUPPORT

- Professional counseling helps patients cope with the emotional toll of cancer and its treatment.
- Registered dietician services can assist in creating meal plans that meet the nutritional needs of patients during and after treatment, addressing side effects like nausea or appetite loss.
- Organizations such as the Cancer Financial Assistance Coalition provide resources to assist with medical bills and treatment costs.

# LOGISTICAL SUPPORT

- The Cancer Compass Beyond The Diagnosis offer In-person support groups once a month for individuals based in Jacksonville, Florida and Virtual Online support group sessions two times a month.
- American Cancer Society: Offers a range of resources, including a 24/7 helpline and navigation assistance.
- Cancer Care: Provides free support services including counseling and a network of healthcare professionals.

Palliative care services focus on improving the patient's quality of life by managing symptoms and providing emotional support, regardless of the stage of the disease.
