

**ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 9-004** 

## A PROCEDURAL RESOLUTION TO REMOVE THE EXTRANEOUS FILING PERIOD AFTER THE CLOSE OF POLLS AND CLARIFY THE STRUCTURE OF THE ELECTION COURT

WHEREAS, The Compiled Code<sup>1</sup> establishes that individuals may file complaints

between 24 and 48 hours after the close of voting alleging violations of

the Elections Code: AND

WHEREAS, Elections results are released at the close of voting; AND

WHEREAS, Allowing individuals to file complaints after results are known

encourages individuals to file baseless complaints based on the voting results for the purpose of disqualifying their competition, instead of in

pursuit of justice; BUT

WHEREAS, A mechanism should still exist in the case that an individual wants a

complaint filed on behavior committed and/or which comes to their attention just before or after the end of the filing period; **AND** 

WHEREAS, Recent changes to the Constitution require a clarification that the Election

Court is a panel of the CSJ whose justices are therefore not appointed by

the Judicial Appointment Commission; THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED,** That Compiled Code Article IV Section B(1)(f)(i)(b) be amended

according to Appendix A; AND BE IT FINALLY

**RESOLVED,** That Compiled Code Article IV Section B(1) be amended by replacing

the words "the court of" with "a panel of CSJ with".

**b. Timing.** Complaints pertaining to an election may only be filed at any-time except for between 0 and 21 hours after before the close of voting in that election, and may not be filed after 18 hours after the close of voting except by the Special Prosecutor, who may file such complaints until it is certified.
