- 3) a short and plain statement of the exact relief demanded (for a civil action) or that the lower judiciary's decision can be reversed or modified, or of the penalty requested (for a disciplinary action).

Each statement included with the filing form shall be simple, concise and direct. No technical forms or patterns of wording are required.
