

ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 7-022

A RESOLUTION URGING COMPENSATION FOR SOCIAL WORK PLACEMENTS

WHEREAS, the School of Social Work (SSW) mandates that Master of Social Work

(MSW) students must work an average of 16 hours per week over 4 semesters in addition to a full course load to successfully complete the

program¹; AND

WHEREAS, SSW students who are required to undertake a one-semester field

placement outside of the United States for successful program completion must work an average of 32 hours per week during that semester²; **AND**

WHEREAS, Social Work students are not only uncompensated for these hours, they

are actually paying the University to work for free, as credit hours are

earned in field placements^{3,4}; **AND**

WHEREAS. 73% of 110 students surveyed by the Fair Labor Organizing (FLO)

Committee work at least one job in addition to their field placement and a full course load, and 40% of those students work 20 hours or more per

week⁵; AND

WHEREAS, the School of Social Work's field placement structure contributes to

financial instability and academic difficulties in its students, and is especially predatory toward low-income and/or out-of-state students⁶;

AND

WHEREAS, there is institutional precedent--in the University's Higher Education⁷ and

Public Health⁸ Master's programs--for the provision of financial

compensation to students completing mandatory internships; and there is

precedent within the social work discipline, as evidenced by the

University of Oklahoma⁹; **AND**

WHEREAS, requiring MSW students to work a substantial number of hours without

compensation is not aligned with the ethical standards of the National

Association of Social Work¹⁰, nor the goals of the University-wide or SSW unit Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion plans^{11,12}; **THEREFORE, BE IT**

RESOLVED,

that the Central Student Government (CSG) Assembly strongly encourages the School of Social Work and its Office of Field Instruction to permanently implement means of compensating students for field placements--through grants; scholarships; reduced or waived tuition costs for credit hours spent in field placement; or stipends provided by field placement agencies--beginning in the Fall 2018 semester; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED,

that CSG fully supports FLO's call for SSW administration to implement a fully need-based means of providing financial aid, as a part of efforts to compensate students for field placement; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED,

that CSG stands with international students, and thus encourages the SSW administration to implement these changes in a way which does not jeopardize their work limitations; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED,

that CSG fully supports FLO's call for restorative justice in the form of one semester of retroactive retribution in the form of grants, scholarships, and/or reduced tuition costs per credit hour that is spent in field placement being provided to Social Work students who are still in the program; **AND BE IT FINALLY**

RESOLVED,

that a copy of this resolution be sent to President Mark J. Schlissel, Vice President E. Royster Harper, and the following SSW Faculty and Staff: Dean Lynn Videka; MSW Program Director Barb Hiltz; Dean Daniel Fischer; Dean Mary Ruffolo; Dean Tim Colenback; Dr. Lorraine Gutiérrez; and Candace Terhune-Flattery.
