

EXECUTIVE ORDER 9-004

ESTABLISHING THE RESEARCH AND POLLING COMMISSION

By the authority vested in me as President and Chief Executive Officer of the University of Michigan Student Body by the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan,

I, Benjamin Gerstein, Student Body President of the University of Michigan, hereby order the establishment of the Research and Polling Commission.

A. Establishment

- 1. The Research and Polling Commission shall work to ensure that Central Student Government leads through data-driven decisions and research.
- 2. The Commission—among other initiatives—will collect and present data to the CSG Executive and Legislative branches on topics that effect campus. These include: mental health, sexual misconduct, food insecurity, campus affordability, and voter registration.
- 3. In addition, the Commission will also collect data as requested by the Legislative and Executive branch of Central Student Government.

B. General Provisions

- 1. The Research and Polling Commission shall be bound by the rules, policies, procedures, and other regulations of task forces, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan and the Compiled Code.
- 2. Members of the Assembly or Executive Commissions who seek the use of the Research and Polling Commission shall make formal requests to the President.
- 3. No provision in this Order is meant to violate, or shall be valid if in violation of, the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan.
- 4. This Order shall be effective immediately on September 3, 2019.

It is so ordered.
