

ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 7-008

**A RESOLUTION TO FUND THE SEXUAL ASSAULT PREVENTION AND
AWARENESS CENTER'S SECOND ANNUAL ACTIVATING OUR CAMPUS
CONFERENCE**

- WHEREAS,** The Sexual Assault Prevention and Awareness Center's (hereafter SAPAC) mission aligns with Central Student Government's (hereafter CSG) mission of improving non-academic life for students, providing a strong basis for stable, continued partnerships and ally-hood; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** the Rape, Abuse & Incest National Network (RAINN) reports that a sexual assault occurs every 107 seconds in the United States¹; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The University of Michigan Report on Sexual Assault and Sexual Misconduct found that 11.4% of students, 22.5% of undergraduate females and 6.8% of undergraduate males were survivors of some form of sexual assault on University of Michigan - Ann Arbor's (hereafter the University of Michigan) campus; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** sexual assault is a pervasive issue on the campus of the University of Michigan, which is apparent due to the University of Michigan's inclusion on the Title IX watch list for sexual assault investigations as of February 1, 2014²; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** SAPAC has dedicated its work and efforts to preventing sexual assault, educating the student body, and providing the necessary resources for a safer campus at the University of Michigan for nearly 30 years, despite its relatively low levels of funding; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** the Activating Our Campus (hereafter AOC) Conference allows student leaders from other universities' sexual assault prevention and awareness programs around Michigan to share resources, attend workshops, and network in order to collaborate and unify against the public health crisis that is campus sexual assault; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** the AOC Conference provides a strong opportunity for CSG, the head campus governance organization at the University of Michigan to show

public support for campus survivors not only in the University of Michigan community, but state- and nation-wide, as well; **AND**

WHEREAS, SAPAC is a department under the University of Michigan's Office of Student Life and, as such, does not qualify for funding from CSG's Student Organization Funding Committee. **THEREFORE, BE IT**

RESOLVED, CSG will provide SAPAC with \$3,000 for the funding of the Fall 2017 AOC Conference; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED, any potential surplus funding leftover from the \$3,000 will be used by SAPAC for the Survivor Care Fund and/or any other resources or events that will further SAPAC's mission and goal; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED, three spots at the AOC Conference will be reserved for any three interested CSG representatives who are interested in attending the AOC Conference and learning about sexual assault prevention and awareness and the various resources that go into this work on a statewide level; **AND BE IT FURTHER**

RESOLVED, CSG will be given the opportunity to facilitate a break-out session on how student government plays a role in the fight against campus gender-based violence and sexual assault and what University of Michigan's CSG is doing to contribute to the conversation around the topic; **AND BE IT FINALLY**

RESOLVED, CSG's branding and marketing logos will be printed and on display at the AOC Conference.
