A RESOLUTION TO HELP FUND AIR CONDITIONING ITEMS IN THE CCRB

WHEREAS,	the University of Michigan is dedicated to the wellbeing of students and their mental health, and thus aims to provide the best environments for student success and comfort; AND			
WHEREAS,	exercise is a prominent and medically documented strong source of stress and anxiety relief, therefore we should—as a CSG dedicated to improving both student mental health and the student experience —work to improve upon existing platforms for stress relief such as gyms and athletic facilities ¹ ; AND			
WHEREAS,	the University of Michigan is currently working on and processing plans for increased fans and air conditioning in the CCRB; THEREFORE BE IT			
RESOLVED,	that Central Student Government should assist University of Michigan Facilities in the funding of this project beginning in the summer, which includes increased air conditioning sources and fans; AND BE IT FURTHER			
RESOLVED,	that \$2,000 ² will be granted from the Central Student Government Legislative Discretionary Fund to the University's CCRB project to fund the installation and purchase of fans and air conditioning, AND BE IT FINALLY			
RESOLVED,	The Central Student Government supports this effort and will work with the proper outlets to assist in its success.
