WHEREAS,	The Career Center has explained that they do not have enough funds to fund a bus as an added accessibility measure for more students; AND			
WHEREAS,	The Career Center needs funds to help promote and expand the Suit Up event and have reach out to more students; AND			
WHEREAS,	The Career Center will plan on having both a stop on North Campus (Pierpont) and Central Campus (The Cube); AND			
WHEREAS,	The Career Center had 388 people check-in and make purchases at the last Suit Up event in September; AND			
WHEREAS,	The Career Center will be providing some transportation to the JCPenney at Briarwood Mall; THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED,	CSG allocates \$340, from the Legislative Discretionary Fund, to provide the Career Center with a bus charter to provide transportation.
