

A RESOLUTION TO HELP FUND THE CAREER CENTER SUIT-UP EVENT

- WHEREAS,** Central Student Government strives to provide resources that are necessary for all students to advance their education at the university¹; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The UM Career Center has created a Clothes Closet that provides free access to professional clothing for students who may not be able to afford it themselves; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The University Career Center offers a program known as “Suit Up”, on February 11th, 2018 which provides new clothes at discounted prices up to 40%; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Career Center has explained that they do not have enough funds to fund a bus as an added accessibility measure for more students; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Career Center needs funds to help promote and expand the Suit Up event and have reach out to more students; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Career Center will plan on having both a stop on North Campus (Pierpont) and Central Campus (The Cube); **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Career Center had 388 people check-in and make purchases at the last Suit Up event in September; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Career Center will be providing some transportation to the JCPenney at Briarwood Mall; **THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED,** CSG will provide funds to the Career Center in order to purchase the charter of the bus in order to provide transportation; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- RESOLVED,** CSG allocates \$340, from the Legislative Discretionary Fund, to provide the Career Center with a bus charter to provide transportation.
