EXECUTIVE ORDER 9-005

ESTABLISHING THE ACADEMIC AFFAIRS COMMISSION

By the authority vested in me as President and Chief Executive Officer of the University of Michigan Student Body by the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan,

I, Benjamin Gerstein, Student Body President of the University of Michigan, hereby order the establishment of the Academic Affairs Commission.

A. Establishment

1. The Academic Affairs Commission shall work to advocate for the enhancement of academic resources at the University of Michigan.
2. The Commission shall conduct research and orchestrate initiatives focused on making the classroom more accessible and inclusive for all students.
3. Further, the Commission shall work with the President and Vice President on new initiatives to improve advising and mentorship across the University's schools and colleges.
4. Lastly, the Commission will involve students in advocacy for a campus more conducive to academic inclusivity.

B. General Provisions

1. The Academic Affairs Commission shall be bound by the rules, policies, procedures, and other regulations of task forces, pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan and the Compiled Code.
2. Members of the Assembly or Executive Commissions who seek the use of the Academic Affairs Commission shall make formal requests to the President.
3. No provision in this Order is meant to violate, or shall be valid if in violation of, the Constitution of the Student Body of the Ann Arbor Campus of the University of Michigan.
4. This Order shall be effective immediately on September 3, 2019.
