

**ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 7-029** 

## A RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE THE REPEAL OF TAX INCENTIVES THAT UNDERMINE HIGHER EDUCATION AND COLLEGE AFFORDABILITY

WHEREAS, The University of Michigan (U-M) is ranked last among 25 "highly selective public universities" on the overall mobility index <sup>1</sup>; AND The University's student body has a parental median income of \$154,000 WHEREAS. <sup>2</sup>, as compared to the Michigan state median income of \$52,491<sup>3</sup>; AND WHEREAS, U-M is committed to ensuring access to quality higher education because, as President Mark Schlissel writes, "higher education has served as a key driver of social mobility and economic growth in American society"<sup>4</sup>; AND The University demonstrates this belief and commitment through WHEREAS, initiatives such as the Go Blue Guarantee,<sup>5</sup> which is designed to address issues of socioeconomic diversity and educational access on this Campus; AND the House of Representatives version of the Federal Tax Cuts and Jobs WHEREAS, Act alters tax incentives meant to relieve higher education financial burdens, namely the elimination of the Lifetime Learning Credit, the Student Loan Interest Deduction, and tuition remission;<sup>6</sup> AND The proposal repeals the Lifetime Learning Credit which "is used by grad WHEREAS. students, workers who need retraining and part-time students and nontraditional undergraduates who take more than four years to graduate" <sup>7</sup>; AND The proposal also eliminates the Student Loan Interest Deduction of the WHEREAS. tax code, which currently functions to allow "institutions to waive or

reduce tuition costs for graduate students without tax implications"<sup>8</sup>; **AND** 

- WHEREAS, The proposal also eliminates tuition remission, which is "a provision of the tax code used by many universities to waive the cost of tuition for graduate students filling positions like teaching assistantships"<sup>9</sup>; AND
- WHEREAS, Elimination of these tax incentives undermines access and affordability of higher education; AND
- WHEREAS, The university-wide plan for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) states that the University is committed to increasing diversity in many ways, including socioeconomic status<sup>10</sup>; AND
- WHEREAS, It is a duty of the CSG to represent and advocate for student interests, especially on issues of educational access and affordability<sup>11</sup>; THEREFORE BE IT
- **RESOLVED,** The CSG opposes the aforementioned repeals that exacerbate limitations on access to higher education; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- **RESOLVED,** The CSG joins President Schlissel in his encouragement of "smarter" tax reform<sup>12</sup>; **AND BE IT FINALLY**
- **RESOLVED,** A copy of this resolution shall be sent to Michigan's representatives in the House and Senate and the members of the tax reform conference committee.
