A RESOLUTION TO PILOT CALCULATOR LOAN PROGRAM ON CAMPUS STUDY SPACES

- WHEREAS,** Central Student Government strives to offer and provide resources that are necessary for any and all students to advance their education at the university¹; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** The Shapiro Library and the Angell Hall Courtyard (also known as the fishbowl) are common study spaces for university students to study in for most or all of the week²; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** Neither of these study spaces currently have a calculator rental/exchange system available for university students to borrow and use while they are in the facility; **AND**
- WHEREAS,** Several students, over many years have mentioned concerns that the cost of calculators is a barrier to their ability to complete homework assignments and study for classes that require one to have a graphing calculator at their disposal; **THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED,** CSG will provide funds for 11 refurbished TI-84 calculators for these libraries to supply to students through an organized and well regulated exchange system; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- RESOLVED,** CSG will help create the efficient rental system that will be implemented in Shapiro and the Angell Hall Courtyard; **AND BE IT FINALLY**
- RESOLVED,** CSG allocates up to \$850, from the Legislative Discretionary Fund, to purchase and ship these calculators from Amazon.
