It is the oldest church in Glencoe but also famous for its role in the 1980s coming of age film, *Sixteen Candles*. Visit the sanctuary, Great Hall and Cornell Hall - and then go home and watch the movie to see how much has changed and how much has remained the same.

- 13 ST. PAUL A.M.E. CHURCH**  
336 Washington Avenue

Stop by and discover the story behind the beautiful stained glass window in the sanctuary of this Glencoe treasure, which is also one of the oldest African American congregations on the North Shore.

- 12 N.S. UNITED METHODIST CHURCH**  
320 Park Avenue  
1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

This religious home for Glencoe's Methodists was built in 1914 and is not open just for you to explore but is also serving refreshments! Stop by to see the beautiful architecture and don't forget to ask about the best items that will be offered in their Rummage Sale on October 5th.

230 Beach Road

How many times have you looked down Greenleaf Ave. or Beach Road and wondered about that huge building at the end of the street? Now is the time to step inside and find out!

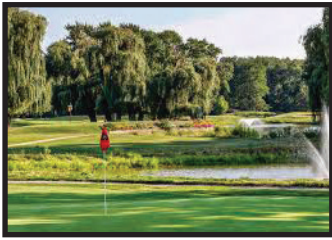

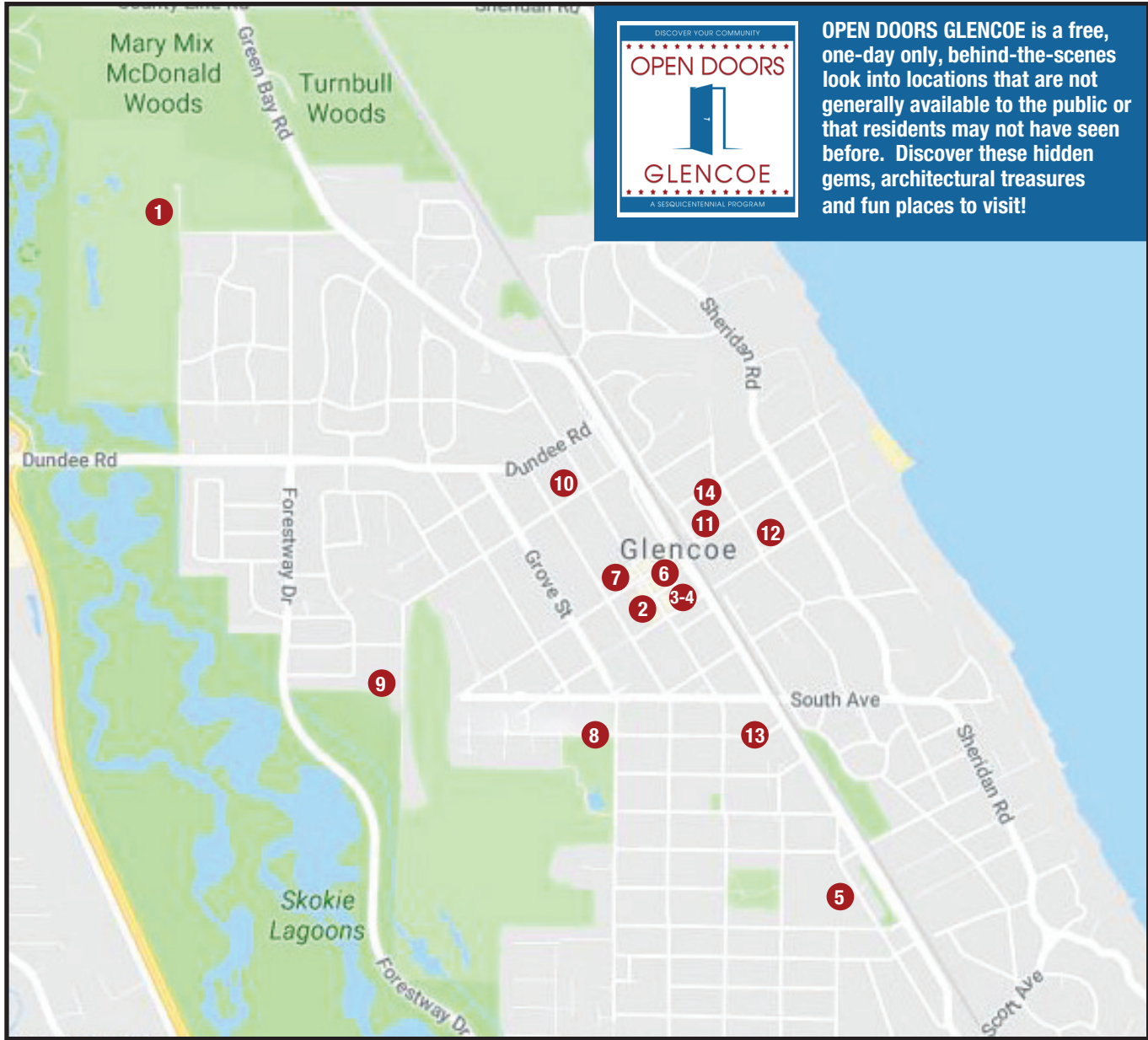

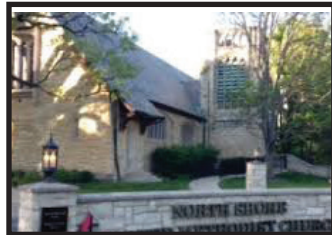
