

Information for Greeters for Children's Ministry on Sunday Morning

Who: Anyone interested in welcoming newcomers and families to St. Philip's

What: You are the first point of contact to welcome visitors and members helping all to feel at-home at St. Philip's Church.

When: There are two shifts (though we encourage you to sign up for both on a Sunday)

Sunday School Greeter: 9:00 - 9:20 am

Children's Church Greeter: 10:10 - 10:30 am

Where: Ground floor portico just outside the doors into the Children's Ministry area

How: Show up. Be welcoming. Direct people to Check-In Station. Answer additional questions.

FAQs from parents:

What time is Sunday School?

Sunday School for children begins at 9:15 am. Adult Sunday School begins at 9:30 am. Parents should pick up children in their classrooms at 10:15 am.

What time is Children's Church?

Children's Church (Room 109) begins at 10:30 am but children may be dropped off as early as 10:15 am. Children will be brought to their parents in the church during Announcements (usually around 11:20 am). Parents should pick up their children in the back of the church at this time.

Where does my child go on Sunday Mornings?

Sunday School Hour (9:15-10:15 am)

- Ages 0-36 months: Nursery Room 108, Parish Building
- 3s and 4s: Room 101, Parish Building
- K5-2nd Grade: Room 106, Parish Building
- 3rd-4th Grade: Room 111, Parish Building
- 5th-6th Grade: Chapel Undercroft
- 7th Grade Confirmation: Tea Garden (Queen Street)
- 8th-12th Grade: Youth Room-2nd Floor, Parish Building

10:30 Worship Service (10:30 am)

- Ages 0-3 years: Nursery Room 108, Parish Building
- 4 years-4th Grade: Room 109, Parish Building

Is there a check-in process?

Yes, we use KidCheck. Parents must create an account to check-in a child. They can do this beforehand or go directly to the Check-In station to create one. Staff is available to assist. Children are given a nematic that includes parent contact information.

Do all children have to be checked in?

No, only those in 4th Grade and younger. Children will not be allowed to leave their classrooms until a parent picks them up (except for those in Children's Church who will be taken to parents).

Do parents have to stay on campus on Sunday morning?

Yes. Parents must stay on campus if their child is checked in. There are multiple adult classes available on Sunday mornings including the Rector's Forum in the Parish Hall on the second floor of the Parish Building.
