PARISH HIRE PART-TIME YOUTH MINISTE CAMPAIGN **PROJECTS**

YOUTH MINISTER (\$47,000)

We need a Youth Minister to help our pastor provide for the spiritual needs of youth in our community, strengthen the connection between the parish and St. John the Baptist School, organize youth activities, and help all young people feel at home in our parish. The dollars earmarked for this project will allow us to hire a part-time youth minister for three years and allow us the time to build our budget to fully support the position.

IMPROVE HALL ACCESSIBILITY **AND AMENITIES (\$75,000)**

We are blessed to have a parish hall; however, it is a bit dated and needs some work. Our goal is to make it a more attractive venue for the community to come together and to generate revenue for the parish. We also want to make it more accessible to all our seniors and the physically challenged so to increase participation in programs hosted in the hall.



INSTALL PROJECTORS AND SCREENS IN THE HALL AND THE CHURCH (\$15,000)

The installation of projectors and screens in the church will enable and encourage greater participation in our worship - which is our highest calling. Also, it will allow us to build community life by hosting faith and study programs, and movie days/nights for seniors, families and youth.

INSTALL ELECTRONIC SIGNAGE (\$28,000)

We want to improve visibility of our parish programmes from King Street. The electronic sign will help us easily and more flexibly post announcements to the community.

RENOVATE ALL CHURCH ENTRANCES (\$50.000)

We value safety and desire the protection of our parishioners and guests. We need to prevent accidents and improve accessibility. This will include repairing the pavement at the Edgemont/ London entrance. Additionally, we want to beautify the entrances to the church – particularly, the mosaic at the King St. entrance - to show we are a welcoming community and we have a special place to share.

CHARITY (\$5,000)

As a church we are called to help the poor and the needy. We plan to engage this mission outreach by donating \$5,000 to the Sisters of the Poor of Jesus for use in their street ministry with the poor and needy in downtown Hamilton.
