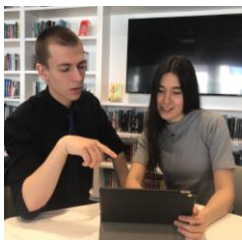

* In order to maintain the quality of learning, in-class learning and outside class learning sessions are divided into morning and afternoon classes.



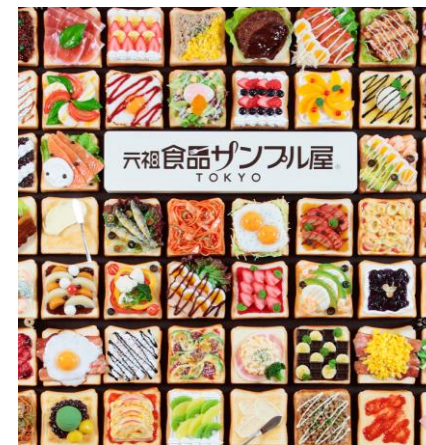
