Developing culturally sensitive and appropriate policies that respond to the needs of UCA members. Fostering models of cross-cultural ministry and mission, outreach and evangelism that reflect the hospitality of God." Let us keep building on the wonderful work that began many years ago, Let us discover what is next for the future generations to come...










As you know we have had the privilege of baptizing a number of children.
