COMPANY PARTICIPATION

BOOTHS

We will have room for 7-9 companies to hold booths. These are first come first serve. We will NOT be charging for these booths, but we do ask that if you hold a booth, please contribute a nonpaper item to the swag bag.

SWAG

Each person who signs up for the event will get a swag bag full of things like dice, pens, or other branded items. If you want to add to the bags, we ask for a minimum of 200 items.

If you would like to donate a larger item to the raffle, each swag bag comes with a raffle ticket, and we will raffle items off throughout the day.

GAMES

During the event, we will hold Magic Drafts, D&D campaigns, and provide space for board games of all kinds. We encourage you to send players with your company logo visible. If you let us know you're coming we will include your company on a signature checklist card. Any person who gets a signature from each company on the card, will get a gift from Game Grid. Regular charges for each participant will apply.
