- Based on the score of the CB assessment
- Example-anticipate dFADs
- Go with other species in PNG

Fishing Ghost Gear handle

- Follow the best fisheries practices of GGGI and FAO guidelines

Traceability onboard

- CDS
- e-CDS
- Tablets onboard
- Monitoring on the sea, verification on the port and validation (VMS)

Labor welfare assessment

- Benchmark tool
- Implementation process
- Set up a management system

- Onsite by CAB-April 8-10
- Scoring report due end of June 2019
- Peer review-due 2 months after comments & action plan
- Public comments -1 month after

- CoC onboard certification – CoC certification
- Joining any MSC traceability trail & initiative (VMS)

- Benchmark against ILO C188, collaborating rating initiative
- Develop of QMS including internal audits and second party
- Publish it and assess by a third party

- Joining any MSC traceability trail & initiative(VMS)

Labor welfare assessment

- Benchmark against ILOC188, collaborating rating initiative – 06.19
- Develop of QMS including internal audits and second party - 12.19
- Publish it and assess by a third party by 2020

 - Fisheries within the country (e.i Prawn)
 - FIP engagement
 - Labor onboard improvement (Crew welfare) incl. supply chain
 - Plastic waste responsible management improvement
