

P.S.H.C.E Curriculum Mapping
Key Stage 3 and 4, (Year 7, 8, 9, 10, 11.)

Aims:

At key stage 3, students build on the knowledge and understanding, skills, attitudes and values they have acquired and developed during the primary phase. PSHE education acknowledges and addresses the changes that young people experience, beginning with transition to secondary school, the challenges of adolescence and their increasing independence. It teaches the knowledge and skills which will equip them for the opportunities and challenges of life. Students learn to manage diverse relationships, their online lives, and the increasing influence of peers and the media.
At key stage 4, students deepen knowledge and understanding, extend and rehearse skills, and further explore attitudes, values and attributes acquired during key stage 3. PSHE education reflects the fact that students are moving towards an independent role in adult life, taking on greater responsibility for themselves and others. With reference to Saint Helena and how it applies on the Island and to its laws etc.
