### **MATCH REPORT - JARRAD PARKER**

A Grade Senior Coach 2019

Round 2 against our local rival and the conditions were perfect for football. We had 5 changes from the week before due to SANFL football, work and travel which earnt A grade debuts for Malachai Ahmatt-Lovett, Lachie Barreau and Sam Abell.

We seemed a bit stunned in the first 10 minutes as Pt Districts dominated possession of the football, then as we started to get to the ball first and use the ball better we came into the game. Three first quarter goals to Ben Lodge, Ned Heath and Malachai Ahmatt-Lovett saw us with our noses ahead at quarter time. That, unfortunately, is where the good news ended.

In the second quarter we were very wasteful with the football and could not get any penetration into our forward lines. We had the same amount of forward 50 entries for the quarter but all of our entries were shallow which allowed them to rebound the football quickly. They were executing their skills well and we were not working hard enough defensively to get behind the football. They kicked 6 goals for the quarter and we only managed the one to Travis Lane.

We were dominated all around the ground in the third quarter as we seemed to lose our way particularly through the middle. Pt Districts were looking dangerous in their forward half as we struggled to clear the ball and they got repeat entries putting our defenders under continued pressure. Even though we were being outplayed, when we did move the ball well and thought about our football we went from coast to coast easily and kicked 3 goals for the quarter to Jackson Smith, Ahmatt-Lovett and Heath.

The last quarter was better from us but it was their ability to get clean entries to their leading forwards which was the difference. Around stoppages they were still on top, we had as much possession of the football as they did but again failed to capitalise in our forward half.

Charlie Morrison was a rock in the backlines under a lot of pressure as was Jake Hyland while Corey Gray never gave up in the middle and was involved in the vast majority of our clearance wins. Kyle Dalidowicz played his first A grade game for the year and showed he wanted to stay there with his tackling and defensive pressure and Liam Martin was again excellent on the wing. Other solid contributors were a couple of our older players in Brad Geddes and Ned Heath.

All in all we were simply beaten by a better team on the day in what was a disappointing day for the club as a whole. We believe we have identified a couple of the main reasons for the result and have begun addressing them with the group, and what better opportunity to regain some respect than on Anzac Day at home.
